Choose sentences from the following or create your own sentences.

Unit 1-01

(Punctuation: ignore, except for capital letters to start sentences. Encourage students to try to spell the words that aren't in the Word List.)

1. He is on that rug. ('rug' is not in the list)
2. Is that bag for you? ('bag' is not in the list - question mark optional)
3. You and the cat are hot. ('cat' and 'hot' are not in the list)
4. Are you in the bed? ('bed' is not in the list - question mark optional)
5. It was in the bag. ('bag' is not in the list)

Unit 1-02

1. A pig is not a dog.
2. A red ant was on the hat. ('hat' is not in the list)
3. He is not to let the pig and the cat on the bed. ('bed' is not in the list)
4. Yes, it was that red dog. (comma not required at this level)

Unit 1-03

1. The man and the cat sat on a bed.
2. Did the man win that red pig?
3. The man he met had to win the red bed.

Unit 1-04

1. Dad fed the red fox in the box.
2. He fed the pet cat.
3. The man had a red hat.
5. The fox bit the pet pig.
6. Dad had to fix the bed for the man.

Unit 1-05

1. A fat frog ran to the pot.
2. It was sad the ten frogs did not fit in the red box.
3. The hot pot is on top of the box.

Unit 1-06

1. He had to sit on the red bus.
2. Dad had just fed the big frog.
3. Is the nut in the bag?
4. He had that bag in the bus.
5. He fed the bag of big nuts to the pet pig.
