





The above letters can be used to make a list word. Write the list word and use the letter to make other words.

Use your dictionary to check or find words.

Rules:

Easier challenge: Using the given letters no more than once, make as many words as possible of **three** or more letters.

For a more difficult challenge: Use the given letters no more than once, make as many words as possible, of **three** or more letters, always including the central letter '**D**'. Capitalised words (proper nouns), plurals, conjugated verbs (past tense e.g., 'hide' not 'hides'), adverbs ending in LY, comparatives and superlatives (adjectives e.g., safer, safest) are disallowed.

General rule:

Do not use acronyms (e.g., ABC), contractions, rude words or slang.

Hints for solving:

- Look for beginnings, such as UN- or SUB-, and endings, such as -ER or -ISM.
 Look for blends, such as ST, PR or ND.
- Write the letters in a different order; you may spot something different.
- Don't forget to look for words that begin with a vowel.
- When you find a word, try reading it backwards, to see if it suggests another word.
- When you find a word, try to find all the rearrangements of its letters that also form words.
- When you find a word, try substituting the remaining letters into it.
